Between Seeing and Remembering


A visual exploration of how memory and photography subconsciously influence my paintings..

I do not paint flowers from life. Instead, they come entirely from my memory, evolving as I work. Each composition becomes a puzzle to solve, a way to balance form, colour, and marks while staying true to the plant's essence. My aim is to distil elements of a moment, using still-life as a metaphor for the passing of time

This book explores the subconscious connections between photography and painting in my practice. Though I never directly reference my photos when I paint, I have come to realize how deeply they influence my work, as do song lyrics. Its as if my memories sit just below the surface, nudging my brush and whispering suggestions.

Looking back at paintings alongside images I captured in the weeks before - light filtering through trees, bright sun shades, interesting shapes, fleeting moments of colour and shadow - I discovered a hidden dialogue between what I see and hear, and what I create.

This book is an attempt to document that conversation, tracing the invisible threads that weave together memory, perception, and my painting practice.






PEARL January 2020 oil on board 25 x 30 cm






BLACK BETTY February 2020 oil on board 25 x 30 cm



COVER ME IN SUNSHINE April 2021 oil and charcoal on board 50 x 50 cm







HAPPY THINGS January 2024 oil on board 25 x 30 cm






YOU BE THE SUNSHINE April 2023 oil on board 25 x 30 cm
